Justus Liebig University (JLU) offers a wide range of subjects across over 100 courses of study. This encompasses the natural and life sciences, social sciences, law and economics as well as the humanities, linguistics and cultural studies. Teacher training courses are also offered.

You can acquire an undergraduate degree by completing an undergraduate course of study. Course duration varies across the different courses of study.

JLU offers the following undergraduate degrees:

- Bachelor of Arts (BA)** for courses in the humanities and social sciences
- Bachelor of Science (BSc)** for courses in mathematics, the natural sciences and economics
- Bachelor of Education (BEd)** for courses in vocational education and training, which can lead, among other things, to a qualification to teach at vocational schools
- State examination** for teacher training courses and courses of study in medicine, law, veterinary medicine and dentistry
