JUSTUS LIEBIG UNIVERSITY GIESSEN

Justus Liebig University (JLU) offers a wide range of subjects across over 100 courses of study. This encompasses the natural and life sciences, social sciences, law and economics as well as the humanities, linguistics and cultural studies. Teacher training courses are also offered.

You can acquire an undergraduate degree by completing an undergraduate course of study. Course duration varies across the different courses of study.

The master's degree courses at JLU are designed to follow directly on from the preceding undergraduate degree, i.e. they offer the opportunity to deepen the knowledge gained from an already acquired degree.

JLU offers the following master's degrees:

- Master of Arts (MA)** for courses in the humanities, linguistics and social sciences
- Master of Science (MSc)** for courses in mathematics, the natural sciences and economics
- Master of Education (MEd)** for courses in vocational education and training, which can lead, among other things, to a qualification to teach at vocational schools
