Application deadlines

Restricted admission programmes:

- 01.06.–15.07. for the winter semester
- 01.12.–15.01. for the summer semester

Unrestricted admission programmes:

- 01.06.–15.08. for the winter semester
- 01.12.–28.02. for the summer semester
