IRPA - History

- Since 1912 Islam is accepted and protected by law in Austria
- Since 1979 IGGÖ is an official muslim representative organisation for all meazabs, including shia
- Since 1982/83 religious teaching in Austrian schools
- 1998 IGGÖ found IRPA as an independent academy for religious teachers training under full responsibility of IGGÖ
- 2007 IRPA becomes university college course
- 2015 cooperation with KPH, IRPA becomes Insitut for islamic religion of KPH Wien / Krems, religious and theologic content of training and teaching continous under responsibility of IGGÖ
- Like all professors of university colleges and universities also those from Institute for islamic religion IRPA are payed by the state

Insitut for islamic religion - IRPA has an exeptional position in Europe. It is the first and oldest institution for islamic religious teachers training in an european country with non muslim majority.

KPH (Kirchlich Pädagogische Hochschule Wien/Krems) has 2500 students and is the biggest private pedagogic university college of Austria.

It is the only pedagogic university college which trains religious teachers for 8 religions:

Islam

- Christian Catholic
- Christian Protestant
- Christian Orthodox
- Christian Independent Churches
 - Judaism
 - Alevism
 - Buddhism






Becoming a religious teacher

- 2015 change to "Lehrerbildung Neu" for Austira
- Now: Bachelor + Master study for becoming a full permissioned teacher for primary schools
- + minimum one of several possible main emphasis to choose, among them Islamic Religion
- (before religious teachers, also teacher for islam, had a solitary traning and magisterium)
