Declaration on a supervision agreement meeting The parties involved declare that, on the basis of a presentation of the doctoral project (e.g. exposé), discussions will be held on central topics of the supervisory relationship and the future joint work and that the results of the discussion will be recorded in joint documentation. The documentation should be updated at appropriate intervals. It can be requested by the doctoral committee if required.	
Possible topics of the discussions are: - Title / topic of the thesis - Obligation to comply with the rules of good scientific practice - Work planning (objectives, partial work, procedure, expected results) - Timing and forms of collaboration - Aspects of the promotion of academic qualifications (beyond the pure doctoral project) - Questions of funding (e.g. doctorate, travelling, conferences) - Aspects of fitting the doctoral project into the life plan - Procedures in cases of conflict or disagreement - Issues relating to updating the supervision agreement.	
The doctoral candidate has the right to ask the supervisor(s) for additional meetings at any time. The supervisor(s) has/have the right to gain insight into the status and progress of the work at any time.
