It is the site of the Spanish government and is the most important financial and cultural center in the country. The cultural, leisure and sports offering is rich and varied, with a large number of theaters and museums, such as the Prado National Art Museum, the Thyssen-Bornemisza Museum and the Queen Sofía Center for the Arts. Monuments, exhibits, and concert halls dot the city. Moreover, in Madrid, over 43 well known parks and green areas, such as the Retiro Park, the “Casa de Campo” Recreational Park or the Sabatini Gardens are frequented by thousands of people every day. Arrival in Madrid: The Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas Airport is located some 14 kms away. There is access to the city by bus, metro or taxi.

Transportation Network: The “Metro” is the quickest way to reach any part of the city (<https://www.metromadrid.es/en>), although Madrid also has a wide network of buses (<https://www.emtmadrid.es/Home>).

Climate: Madrid has a continental Mediterranean climate. Winters are cold, with temperatures below 6º C, frost at night and occasional snow. Summers are hot with average temperatures around 24ºC in July and August, with highs that sometimes exceed 35ºC.

Library: The Universidad Pontificia Comillas has an extensive Library System, with the Main Library on the Cantoblanco Campus and a second Reference Library downtown, which provides a wide selection of bibliographical material and documents to cover its teaching, study and research needs.

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

International students must have sufficient knowledge of Spanish, since most classes are taught in this language (unless they are following a study plan in English). Free and supplementary language classes are offered, financed by the erasmus Program. The subject is called “Spanish Language for Exchange Students” and carries a value of 4.5 ects credits. In order to receive these credits, students must attend classes and pass the exam. An on-line level test for Spanish Language should be taken by those exchange students who are interested in enrolling in this course.

Levels A2, B1, B2 and C1 are offered.

MH Matrícula de Honor.

This mark is awarded to a small number of students who have demonstrated exceptional work.

SB “Sobresaliente” (Outstanding).
This mark is given to students who have demonstrated outstanding work.

NT Notable.
Se concede a estudiantes con rendimiento medio alto.
NT “Notable” (Noteworthy).
This mark is given to students for good work, in a range of “good” to “very good”.

AP Aprobado.
Indica que el estudiante ha superado la asignatura con nivel suficiente.
AP “Aprobado” (Pass).
This mark indicates that the student has passed the subject with a sufficient level, in a range of “passing” to “good”.

SS Suspenso.
El alumno no ha superado la asignatura y debe presentarse a un nuevo examen.
SS “Suspenso” (Fail).
The student has not passed the course and should re-sit for the exam at a later date, or receives a “Fail” for the class on the transcript.
