Information on Data Protection

Justus Liebig University Giessen (JLU) is processing your personal data for the purpose of doctoral student and examination statistics and for implementation and administration of doctoral examination procedures. The lawful basis is Article 6, paragraph 1 c) and e) of the European General Data Protection Regulation in conjunction with the Higher Education Statistics Act (HStatG), in particular § 5 and § 7, and with § 12 paragraph 8 of the Hessian Higher Education Act (HHG); also, in the case of higher education enrolment, with § 13 of the Hessian Higher Education Enrolment Regulation (HImV) and, in the case of an employment contract with the university, also in conjunction with § 34 paragraph 1 of the Hessian Data Protection and Freedom of Information Act (HDSIG).

Your obligation to provide the data, without which administration and implementation of doctoral examination procedures would not be possible, has its basis in the doctoral degree regulations valid for your faculty/institution, and, in the case of your higher education enrolment, in § 15 and § 13 HImV. Your data may be disclosed to those employees of JLU or of other authorities in public administration who require the data in order to carry out their public-sector duties. Pursuant to § 10 paragraph 2 HStatG, the institutions of higher education are required to give information to the Hessian Federal State Office of Statistics for the purpose of providing the statistics mentioned in paragraph 1 of this information.

Unless specific retention periods result from § 15 and § 21 HImV, your data will be stored as long as they are required for accomplishing the named purposes. You have the right at any time to request information about your data and to obtain rectification of inaccurate data or to obtain restriction of the processing of inaccurate data (Articles 15, 16 and 18 of the European General Data Protection Regulation). If you consider the processing of your data to be unlawful, you may lodge a complaint with the Hessian Data Protection Officer (Article 77 of the European General Data Protection Regulation, § 55 of the Hessian Data Protection and Freedom of Information Act).
