PROFILE: HEISENBERG PROGRAMME (DFG)

1. SUMMARY

The aim of the program is to promote scientists who are already eligible for professorships and who also stand out for their particularly outstanding scientific achievements. The Heisenberg Program offers a choice of four funding options, which can be combined if the respective requirements are met.

2. REQUIREMENTS

Researchers who are eligible to apply are primarily those who have obtained their appointment through the Emmy Noether Program, DFG project positions, research activities in industry or positions in academic midlevel positions. The target group also includes junior research group leaders, junior professors with positive evaluations, post-doctoral lecturers and researchers returning from abroad or foreign academics who wish to work in Germany, are suitably qualified and are not yet employed as a full professor at their current institution. Eligibility to apply can also be achieved through other habilitation-equivalent achievements.
