

PROFILE: INDIVIDUAL RESEARCH GRANTS

1. SUMMARY

The individual research grant enables all persons with completed scientific training to carry out a single, thematically and time-limited research project at any time, regardless of the topic.

There are various modules with different characteristics that can be applied for under the DFG individual research grant. Depending on the program objective, applicants can apply for one or more of the modules offered. The grant can be applied for at any time.

2. REQUIREMENTS

Scientists of all disciplines at German research institutions with a completed scientific education (usually a doctorate) are eligible. Members of an institution that only serves commercial purposes and members of an institution that is not permitted to publish results in a generally accessible form are not eligible.
