

PROFILE: RESEARCH TRAINING GROUPS

1. SUMMARY

In Research Training Groups, innovative, excellent research and the related, structured support of researchers in early career phases form a unit. The focus is on the qualification of doctoral candidates within the framework of a focused research program and a structured qualification concept that prepares doctoral candidates for the complex job market for scientists. With its Research Training Groups, the German Research Foundation supports outstanding and particularly innovative research projects. The program aims to further develop the structure of the doctoral phase and thus contribute to increasing the attractiveness of doctoral studies. International Research Training Groups can also be funded.

2. REQUIREMENTS

Universities and equivalent higher education institutions with the right to award doctorates are eligible to apply. The application is formulated jointly by the responsible university lecturers involved. A designated spokesperson takes the lead in the application and must have a permanent position and all the rights and obligations of full-time professors.
