**Coded Countries:** Brazil, China, France, Germany, India, Italy, Japan, Russia, United Kingdom, United States of America

- ... constructing a bottom-up national identity database from 1950 onwards (every 10 years) ... on the grounds of five mass and elite text-
  - genres (letters, movies, newspapers, novels, speeches)
  - ... using <u>discourse analysis</u> and (later) <u>quantification</u> (relative salience; valence)
- ... to produce a more valid, intersubjectively meaningful measurement of national identity than existing proxy variables for comparative scholarship
  - ... to analyze great power relations, with the ultimate goal of constructing a database of all great power identities from 1810 to the present
