You will **arrive late** for your studies

You have received conditional admission

You can take the **digital Bachelor courses** to fulfill
the admission conditions

You have to arrive to Giessen to take the exams in person in March 2025 at the latest.

You have **NO** admission conditions

You start with the master's program later, e.g. in the second semester (April 2025)

In terms of examination law, there are <u>no consequences</u> if you do not take any courses in the first semester

Conditional Admission



Conditional admission Master EGR: In the first two semesters, 30 ECTS in the field of economics must be completed additionally. For this purpose, all bachelor's modules from the Department of Economics and Business Studies (FB 02, JLU) with the module code 02-VWL: BSc... and the moduls Introduction to Microeconomics and Introduction to Macroeconomics can be taken. (31.08.2024)

Each course has 6 ECTS, so that:

30 ECTS = 5 Courses

- Don't worry, we have enough english-taught courses on Bachelor level!
- Most of them are available online in video format and can be taken outside the university
- You have to complete the conditions in the first <u>two semesters</u>. There is no possibility to postpone the deadline even in case of late arrival due to e.g. visa issues.
- Feel free to take courses in your country and have your credits recognized at the JLU.


