

Marie Curie Research Fellowship in Econometrics

The Chair of Econometrics at the Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin is offering a Research Fellowship (Ph.D. position) starting in the summer of 2008 and ending 14.12.2010. The researcher is expected to work in the Marie Curie Research and Training Network “Computational Methods in Statistics, Econometrics and Finance“ (COMISEF).

Applicants should have an above-average degree in Economics, an excellent background in statistics and econometrics, and good English language skills.

Applicants must fulfill the requirements for the Marie Curie Program. The offer is aimed at pre-doctoral applicants who have completed their degree no longer than four years ago and have not resided in Germany for any longer periods within the last four years. Nationals from a Member State of the European Union or an Associated State will be given priority.

The Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin seeks to increase the number of women in research and teaching and therefore invites particularly qualified female researchers to apply for the position. Disabled applicants are treated with priority when equally qualified.
